### Revised page numbering

We are pleased that Endangered Species Research (ESR), which began in 2004 as an online-only journal, is now also available as a print publication.

With the launch of ESR's first print issues — Volume 1, containing articles appearing in 2004 and 2005, and Volume 2, containing articles appearing in 2006 — the volume, number, article and page numbering system has been changed retroactively.

The changes made to the citation format of each article published in Volume 2 and later repaginated are shown in the table below, and on the title page of

the articles themselves. The new numbering system was used exclusively for all articles published from November 2006.
