Fig. S1. Mean daily biovolumes and numerical densities of *Mnemiopsis* and *Chrysaora* between 2003 and 2005. All Tucker trawl samples are included except bottom samples in Mackall Cove; these were taken only in 2005 to examine vertical behavior relative to tides. Error bars are not included in figures because except for 2005, means are of 2 replicate tows per site and depth. Symbols: Filled red square = mainstem Patuxent surface layer; open red square = mainstem Patuxent whole water column (2003) or bottom layer (2004-2005); blue circle = cove; downward closed triangle = lower creek surface; downward open triangle = lower creek whole water column (2003) or bottom layer (2004-2005) – St. Leonard Creek only; upward closed triangle = upper creek
