

FISHER INTERVIEW - INDIA

INSTRUCTIONS

This questionnaire has **six** sections. The below statement must be read to the fishers before conducting the interview while explaining that it is going to take half 30 to 45 mins to complete it. The interview has to be done <u>with the fisher alone</u>, without other people.

If a fisher does not answer one of the questions, list one of these reasons: does not want to respond, does not know, or does not understand.

• **Do you know what these are?** (show ID sheet of species)

This is where you can start noting down the local names of the various species and what features allow them to tell apart the species (e.g., spot patterns, sizes, location of fins, size of fins...) – DO NOT LEAD – Just note what differences they are mentioning, if any.

- If the respondent does not know what these animals are:
 - 1. Show them the map and determine which area(s) they usually fish
 - **2.** Thank them and move to the next fisher
 - 3. Make sure to note how many people did not know what these species are.

NOTE: Most fishers are likely unable to read maps -- If they can't read the map, try and get names of landmark locations such as names of villages, landing sites, bays, general directions (north, south, out at sea for 10 km...)
